DENR Special Order No. <u>537</u> Series of 1991

SUBJECT: Creation of a Multi - Sectoral Ad Hoc Committee called Kapit - Bisig sa Pakatan.

In the interest of the service upon and in order to facilitate provision of technical assistance leading to the awarding of a Mangrove Stewardship Agreement to the people's organization of Infanta, Quezon named SIPAKAT (Samahang Ipinagtatanggol ang Pakatan), a Multi - Sectoral Ad Hoc Committee called Kapit - Bisig sa Pakatan is hereby created to be composed of the following:

The Committee shall have the following functions:

1. Be responsible for the delineation survey of the mangrove area being applied by the SIPAKAT (Samahang Ipinagtatanggol ang Pakatan) a people's organization of Infanta, Quezon, leading to the award of a Mangrove Stewardship Agreement pursuant to DAO # 03, Series of 1991.

- 2. Verify adverse claims over the area if any and prepare the necesarry recommendations to the Secretary of DENR to clear the way for a Mangrove Stewardship Agreement.
- 3. Oversee the processing of all requirements leading to the award of a Mangrove Stewardship Agreement to the SIPAKAT.
- 4. Coordinate and thresh out inter agency problems in relation to the above issues.

The committee shall initially meet at Infanta, Quezon on May 16, 1991 and be ready with the draft MSA by the 15th of June, 1991.

All expenses incurred by the above mentioned committee members while on official travel will be charged against the fund of their respective offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately and remain in force until the draft MSA shall have been submitted to the Office of the Secretary of DENR.
