SUBJECT : Authorizing the Low-Income Upland Communities Project (LIUCP) to Conduct Trainor's Training on Community Reforestation and the Participation of LIUCP Personnel, NGO Representatives and Community Members

1. In the interest of the service and in pursuance of the objectives of the Low-Income Upland Communities Project particularly on Agroforestry, Reforestation and Livelihood component, the Project is hereby authorized to hold a Trainor's Training on Community Reforestation.
2. The Training-Seminar will be held from June 24 to 29, 1991 at the Traveller's Inn, Adriatico Street, Calapan, Oriental Mindoro administered by the LIUCP Local Consultants on Extension/Training and Upland Agriculture supported by the Provincial Project Managers.
3. At the end of the Training, the participants shall have:
 - a. Situated the bio-physical and social development aspects of reforestation in a community-based upland development project;
 - b. Acquired knowledge and skills in reforestation and be able to share what they have learned to the community members; and
 - c. Formulated approaches and strategies for the preparation of a community reforestation plan for the different Site Management Unit (SMU-1).


c. Community Members (12 community leaders; 2 per SMU)
