The yearly conduct of in-house review and field evaluation of the ongoing and completed projects of the DENR Research Sector being spearheaded by ERDB in coordination with PCARRD and the regional consorta serves not only as an occasion to evaluate regional R and D accomplishments but also as a forum to raise and discuss some issues and problems relevant to the implementation of the R and D projects.

The overall synthesis of the recently concluded in-house reviews and field evaluation of the DENR regional R and D projects generated some pressing issues and problems common to all regions. Such issues need to be exhaustively deliberated upon by the concerned parties en-banc in order to derive cohesive and coherent solutions.

In view of this, ERDB deemed it necessary to gather all RTDs for Research to review and validate the synthesis of each region's in-house review outputs and at the same time resolve some issues and problems that cropped up during the evaluation to ensure that unified solutions must be evolved by the sector.
