
SUBJECT : Paitan Project

1. 

2. Mr. Estelito C. Coronado shall continue to act as coordinator for the Office of Luzon Regional Operations to conduct regular visits and to provide support to the Committee.
3. The ICAD-SCO shall continue to monitor and evaluate the activities and progress of the project.
4. This project shall be pursued in close coordination with the Office of the Provincial Governor.
5. All expenses shall be charged to respective offices, unless otherwise indicated by this Office.
6. This Order shall take effect on 1 February 1991 and shall remain valid until revoked. All previous orders inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked.
