

As Project Leaders, they shall be responsible for the preparation and implementation of the projects' Work and Financial Plans. Except for those projects contracted to agencies outside DENR, the Project Leaders shall be under the direct supervision of their respective Regional Executive Directors/Bureau Directors and shall perform the following administrative and financial functions:

- a. Establish coordination mechanics at the Central and Regional Offices of the Department to support project implementation requirements;
- b. Recommend approval of Travel Orders and Itinerary of Travel of project personnel covering official trip for a period not exceeding thirty days (30) days;
- c. Recommend the approval of quarterly plantilla of appointments of project personnel;
- d. Recommend the approval of payrolls and enter into contract of labor for the implementation of project activities;
- e. Draw cash advance from the project allotment not exceeding an amount of TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P25,000) per quarter for payment of emergency purchases of field supplies and materials and contract of labor subject to the inspection and approval of CENRO or PENRO concerned;


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- f. Recommend the approval of Disbursement Vouchers for payment of project expenditures such as travels, payrolls, labor contracts and supplies and materials, etc.;
 - g. Recommend approval of RIVs, Purchase/Letter Orders for emergency purchases of necessary supplies and materials;
 - h. Submit monthly accomplishment reports not later than the 10th day of the following month to the SPD-FASPO using the prescribed form (PPPMO Form No. 1a) duly endorsed by the Regional-Executive Directors/Bureau Directors;
 - i. Perform other project-related functions as may be assigned by appropriate authorities.


The exercise of the above functions shall, in all cases, be subject to the quarterly/annual Work and Financial Plan recommended by the RED/Bureau Director concerned and approved by the Assistant Secretary for Foreign Assisted and Special Projects, Travel Plans and Procurement Plans approved by the REDs/Bureau Directors or his duly authorized representative, and to the national/agency policies, laws, rules and regulations pertinent thereto.


They shall be entitled to reasonable transportation/representation allowances or honorarium, subject to the approval of the Secretary or his designated representative and under existing laws, rules and regulations.


