SUBJECT: Creation of a Team to conduct identification and delineation of actual occupation/kaingin of Lumads within Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project.

1. In the interest of the service and consistent with the constitutional mandate for the recognition and protection of the rights of the indigenous cultural communities to their ancestral lands to ensure their social, economic and cultural well-being, a team that is responsible for the identification, evaluation and delineation of actual occupation/kaingin of Lumads within Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project in Region 10 is hereby created to be composed of the following:

Michael E. Montalban, Team Leader, ICAD-SCD

One (1) Representative, Member, ICAD-SCD

One (1) Representative, Member, DENR-R10

One (1) Representative, Member, BIPP-PMS

2. The Team shall identify, evaluate and delineate actual occupations/kaingins by actual ground survey for plotting in a compilation map.

3. The Team shall coordinate with the Regional Executive Director, Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project, other concerned government agencies and non-governmental organizations on the verification of the authenticity of all ancestral land claims by taking into consideration the indigenous customs and practices regarding land use, ownership, and management.

4. The compilation map if any there be, prepared by the Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project, together with all the pertinent documents thereof shall be turned over to the herein team.

5. The Team shall prepare separate guidelines in the identification, evaluation and delineation of ancestral land claims within Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project. It shall classify the applicants for ancestral land claims based on the prepared guidelines.

6. The Team is hereby authorized to avail of the services of any employee of the Department and/or any of the bureaus and offices and available equipment in the official discharge of its functions.

7. Members of the Team shall be entitled to a monthly reasonable allowance, travelling expenses, per diems and other incidental expenses chargeable against the Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project Funds subject to existing accounting rules and regulations.

8. This order shall take effect immediately.

**METHODOLOGY:**

1. The team shall conduct interviews and a research on all existing records of the Census and socio-economic profile of the Barangay's and municipalities affected by the operation of the Bukidnon Industrial Plantation Project. It is presumed that the BIPP Project has prepared the mapping-up of those members which was directly affected or has an occupation within the project area.

2. The team shall conduct an actual ground verification on actual occupation/kaingins of the Lumads within BIPP and the drawing up of appropriate boundaries.
3. The team shall prepare a separate map on the relative locations of the areas occupied by the Lumads within and adjacent to BIPP area and present it to the Secretary upon termination of the task.

### DELINEATION SCHEDULE

- September 1991 - Interview and Research of all existing records on  
(1-20) the Census and socio-economic profile of Barangay's and Municipalities affected by the operation of BIPP.
- October 1991 - Collation of all data.  
(1-5)
- (6-20) - Actual ground verifications of occupants/kaingins of Lumads.
- November 1991 - Delineation/drawing-up of approximate boundaries on the ground.
- December 1991 - Monumenting or setting-up of landmarks.
