The Chairman shall oversee the overall implementation of project activities related to IEC. He shall be responsible in coordinating and ensuring the smooth operation of IEC related activities.


The Deputy for Programming shall be responsible for the proper scheduling, planning and monitoring of all activities of the Secretariat.
