SUBJECT: OBSERVANCE OF NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH IN OCTOBER
1991.

In the interest of the service and pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, NSCB Memorandum Circular No. 02-91, and in line with the Second Celebration of the National Statistics Month in October 1991, the DENR Technical Secretariat for Statistical Concerns and Coordination is hereby tasked to undertake the following activities:

1. Training Workshop on Statistical Methods for ENR Activities - September 23 to October 1, and November 4-22, 1991 at NTC-RD, Los Baños, Laguna.
2. Exhibit of Statistical Publications - October 14-25, 1991 at DENR lobby in coordination with the Public Affairs Office.
3. Symposium on the Natural Resource Accounting Project - October 24, 1991, DENR Training Center.
4. Demonstration of Computer Systems (ENR Information Systems and Geographic Information System) - October 24, 1991 at NAMRIA.


The observance of this event has two-fold objectives, viz. (a) to promote, enhance and instill nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society, and (b) to elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standard of statistics in the country. The theme for this month's celebration is:

"STATISTICS IN SUPPORT OF DECENTRALIZATION"

In view of the foregoing, the DENR Technical Secretariat for Statistical Concerns and Coordination is hereby authorized to seek assistance from any employee or official of agencies under the Department in pursuance of this order.

Any expenses incurred in connection with this order shall be allowed chargeable against the concerned agencies' statistical budget subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately and shall be revoked on November 1, 1991.
