By virtue of this deputation, the named project personnel shall be authorized to detect and investigate violations of forestry laws, rules, and regulations; and to arrest even without warrant any person(s) who has committed, is committing or about to commit any of the offenses defined in the Revised Forestry Code within their areas of concern.

The named personnel shall be authorized to seize and confiscate the tools and equipment used in committing the offense and the forest products cut, gathered or removed by the offender(s) in the process of the illegal activity.

These personnel shall be authorized to administer oath and take acknowledgment in official matters connected with their functions in the project, and to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the authority of the Revised Forestry Code and its its implementing rules and regulations.

The Project Leaders of the three reserves shall provide the Offices of the Undersecretary for Field Operations and the OIC-Office of the Undersecretary for Environment and Research with quarterly reports of the cases, if any, handled by their respective projects pursuant to this deputation order.

This Order takes efffect immediately and revokes previously issued DENR Special Orders to this effect, and shall remain in force until December 31, 1992 or unless otherwise revoked or amended in writing by the appropriate DENR authorities.
