SUBJECT: Formation of IEC Groups and Designation of Provincial Coordinators in the Six Pilot Regions of the Population-Environment IEC Programme

In the interest of the service and in order to enhance project implementation of the DENR-FAO-UNFPA Population-Environment IEC Programme, the formation of an IEC Group consisting of Information and social forestry personnel in 34 provinces in six pilot regions (Region 1, 3, 6, 7, 10, and 11) is hereby created:

Chief, Regional Public Affairs Office in the 6 regions Information Officer in the 6 regions

Chief, Social Forestry Division in the 6 regions

Community Development Officer in the 77 model ISF sites in the 6 regions

Community Development Assistant in the 77 model ISF sites in the 6 regions

Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Information Officer in the 34 provinces

Community Environment & Natural Resources Information Officer in model ISF sites.

The IEC group is charged with the planning, implementation and monitoring of the Field Implementation Phase of the project in their respective regions, provinces and communities.

Specifically, the IEC group shall perform the following tasks:

- a) oversee the conduct of the field implementation, including the campaign period;
- b) facilitate contact with relevant local government and nongovernment personnel and officials who will be involved in the field implementation, in consultation with the target beneficiaries and the staff; and
- c) oversee the conduct of the monitoring scheme and write a monthly report, within the campaign period;
- perform other related activities.

The PENRO information officers in the six pilot provinces who are hereby designated provincial coordinators of the IEC group of the Population-Environment IEC Programme are as follows:

- 1. Region I - Alberzon Sagun (Pangasinan)
- 2. Region 3 - Melanie Bernabe (Bataan)

3. Region 6 - Fernando Besana (Capiz)

4. Region 7 - Arnold Jugan (Cebu)

5. Region 10 - Lina Calvez (Bukidnon)

6. Region II - Nenita Sumaylo (Davao Sur)

As coordinators, they shall be tasked in a) helping plan, implement, including linkages with government and non-government organizations, and monitor the field implementation activities and other related tasks in the communities in their respective provinces, and b) prepare/submit a monthly report within field implementation/campaign period and through their respective regional executive directors to central Public Affairs Office. The report shall be submitted on or before a week after each month.

This order takes effect immediately.
