SUBJECT:

Reorganizing the Navotas-Malabon-Tullahan-Tinajeros (NMTT) Rivers Revival Project Management Office and the Task Force on

Industrial Wastes

In the interest of the service and the speedy implementation the Navotas-Malabon-Tenejeros-Tullahan (NMTT) Pollution and Flood Control Program, the Rivers Revival Project Management Office (PMO) and the Task Force on Industrial Wastes is hereby reorganized under the administrative jurisdiction of the DENR-NCR notwithstanding the financial and budgetary support from the DENR Central Office.

The PMO shall have the following functions:

- Plan and implement appropriate environmental protection measures in consonance with the Rivers Revival Project;
- Coordination of the tasks of other government agencies involved in the Memorandum of Agreement of the NMTT Pollution and Flood Control Project;
- 3. Prepare the technical, administrative, and budgetary requirements to support the Framework Plan and the specific tasks assigned by the undersigned from time to time;
