SUBJECT:

- 1. 3. The teams shall monitor/evaluate the CY 1991 accomplishments enrichment planting, Timber Stand Improvement (TSI) and CY 1989 & 1990 established plantations. The team shall

see to it that log landings, logging set-up such as cable ways, etc. abandoned kaingin and all open areas less than five hectares were being enriched by the company. The area enriched shall be determined by random sampling using 5% intensity. Each sample plot shall be measured $10 \text{ m} \times 25 \text{ m}$. They shall indicate in the map the locations of the area/areas/enriched.

- 4. They shall coordinate with the RED, PENRO's and CENRO's concerned and shall avail of the services of any field personnel and facilitates necessary to carry out the activity.
- 5. The teams shall submit their reports accompanied with photographs to the Secretary thru the FMB Director within seven (7) days after completion of their field work.
- 6. They shall be entitled to reasonable transportation expenses, allowances and per diems subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations chargeable against the interest of the Reforestation Trust Fund Deposit.
- 7. A coordinating and Review Committee shall be created to supervise the conduct of field monitoring and evaluation and the analyses of the findings of the teams. The Committee shall be composed of the following:
