SUBJECT : CREATION OF THE SURIGAO MINERAL RESERVATION
MONITORING TEAM (SMRMT)

In the interest of the service and to provide effective over-all supervision of all activities within Parcel I (Mainland Surigao del Norte and Carrascal, Surigao del Sur); Parcel II (Islands of Masapelid, Nonoc and part of Dinagat); and Parcel III (Dinagat Island) of the Surigao Mineral Reservation, the SURIGAO MINERAL RESERVATION MONITORING TEAM (SMRMT) is hereby established under the organizational structure/personnel presented below:

The SMRMT shall have the following objectives:

1. To oversee, assess, and record production and shipments in the Surigao Mineral Reservation especially from small scale mining areas mainly for the proper collection of government share, royalties and other taxes.

2. To assist small-scale miners in administrative and legal procedures including formation of cooperatives to ensure attainment and maintenance of legal status.


3. To provide technical assistance to small scale miners in the specific area of safety, mine and mill technology, survey, environment consciousness, financing and economic concerns.

4. To serve as liaison between small scale miners and medium/big-scale mining operators to ensure mutually beneficial co-existence.

5. To implement DENR Administrative Order No. 40, Series of 1991, providing for the Procedures on the Collection and Remittance of the 2% Replenishment Contribution to UNRFNRE from Ores Extracted or Shipped Out in Dinagat Island, Surigao del Norte.

The Mines and Geo-Sciences Bureau shall serve as the Head Office while the Office of the Surigao del Norte PENRO shall serve as the Field Office.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
