SUBJECT : Assigning the Wildlife Regulation and CITES Section under the Office of the Director of PAWB and Converting the same into the CITES Management Office.

In the interest of the service and in view of the authority granted to the Director of PAWB to approve CITES Permits and Wildlife Export Certifications in pursuance to the DENR's objective of giving expeditious services to the public thru an "Express Wildlife Export Processing System", the Wildlife Regulation and CITES Section in charge of processing all wildlife permit shall now be placed under the Office of the Director of PAWB.

In addition, the abovesited section shall be considered as the CITES Management Staff and will discharge the functions required in the effective enforcement of the CITES Treaty in addition to their usual wildlife regulatory work.

The Office of the Director of PAWB shall submit a monthly report to the undersigned through the Undersecretary for Environment and Research on the issuances of permits together with copies of permits issued.

This Order takes effect immediately and supersedes/revokes all other orders inconsistent herewith.
