In the interest of the service and in order to review the performance of DENR Central and Regional Offices as well as resolve policy, administrative and operational issues, a National MANCON will be held at Casa Blanca Convention Center, Hotel Casa Blanca, Legaspi City on August 18 - 21, 1993.
