
DENR Special Order  
No. 106

SUBJECT : Creation of Forest Inventory Teams to evaluate and conduct a 10% timber inventory within Block I of Aurora Timber Industries Corp. (ATICOR), holder of TLA No. 112, located in Maria Aurora, Dipaculao and Baler, Province of Aurora and Maddela, Province of Quirino.


1. Pursuant to the provisions of DENR Administrative Order No. 24 and DENR Memorandum Order No. 8, both Series of 1991, shifting logging operation from the old growth (virgin) forest to the second growth (residual) forest, three (3) forest inventory teams are hereby created to evaluate and conduct a 10% timber inventory of the second growth forest, Block I of ATICOR, holder of TLA No. 112, located at the Provinces of Aurora and Quirino.
2. The teams shall be composed of the following:

a. Team Leader Member	Nestor A. Bambalan, FMB Reg'1/PENRO/CENRO Representative
b. Team Leader Member	Arvie Tirso Caancan, FMB Reg'1/PENRO/CENRO Representative
c. Team Leader Member	Rene S. Siapno, FMB Reg'1/PENRO/CENRO Representative
3. The teams shall evaluate the operable second growth forest, Block I of ATICOR in accordance with the provisions of DENR Memorandum Order No. 8, Series of 1991.
4. The teams are authorized to hire five (5) laborers for each team to assist them in the conduct of the timber resources evaluation.
5. The teams shall submit a comprehensive report to the Undersecretary for Field Operations, thru the FMB Director within fifteen (15) calendar days upon completion of their field work.

6. All expenses incidental to the conduct of the timber inventory shall be charged against the trust fund deposit of ATICOR, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. This Order shall take effect immediately.
