SUBJECT : Creation of a Special Committee to Monitor and Maintain the Seedlings/Saplings Planted Along Congressional Avenue, Quezon City under the Adopt-A-Street Program Pursuant to Executive Order No. 100

In the interest of the service and in order to ensure the survival and protection of the planted seedlings/saplings of various species along Congressional Avenue, Quezon City, a Special Committee is hereby created to be composed of the following FMB Technical personnel:

The Committee shall be responsible for the protection and maintenance of the planted seedlings/saplings. The replanting of dead and diseased seedlings/saplings shall be coordinated with the RED, DENR-NCR, who shall provide the necessary planting tools and materials.

The Chairman shall convene immediately the Special Committee in order to prepare the work program, strategies and activities to be undertaken for the effective protection and maintenance of the seedlings/saplings.

The Committee shall coordinate with the Barangay Officials and appropriate law enforcement/police authorities within Congressional Avenue, Quezon City to apprise them of the DENR project in the locality and solicit their cooperation, assistance and support in the protection of the area against elements of destruction.

The Committee shall conduct monitoring and inspection of the project starting August 1993 and every month thereafter. A monthly status report shall be submitted to the DENR Secretary through the FMB Director.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
