SUBJECT: Creation of a Transition Management Staff (TMS) for the Calauit Project.

In the exigency of the service and in view of the devolution of the management of the Calauit Project to the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) pursuant to R.A. 7611 (SEP Act) and the eventual termination of the management services of CRMF, Inc., a Transition Management Staff, responsible for the temporary management of the Project is hereby created to be composed of the following:

- 1) Mr. Benigno de Guzman, Sr. - Project Coordinator
OIC, CENRO, Coron, Palawan
- 2) Ms. Josefina de Leon - Asst. Project Coordinator
Protected Areas and Wildlife Bureau
- 3) Representative from DENR - Member
- 4) Representative from PCSD - Member
- 5) Representative from CRMFI - Member

The Staff shall:

- 1) Orient/reorient all project personnel absorbed by the new management about employee-employer arrangements;
- 2) Prepare new project directions in the light of the management transfer;
- 3) Conduct/facilitate final inventory and turn-over of Calauit Project facilities and equipment;
- 4) Regularly implement activities in the Calauit Project; and
- 5) Ensure full implementation of all the rules and regulations covering the Island sanctuary.



The Staff shall submit progress reports and recommendations concerning Calauit Project management to the Secretary, DENR and PCSD;

The Project Coordinator is authorized to sign correspondence and recommendations concerning Calauit Project personnel and other administrative matters pertaining to Calauit Project operations, including fund disbursement, copy furnished the Director, PAWB;


The Staff is authorized to avail itself of the assistance/services of any employee of the Department and/or any of its Bureaus and Offices in the pursuance of its tasks;

All maintenance and operating expenses including transportation expenses and per diems of TMS members, which shall be incurred in the management of Calauit Project, shall be chargeable against Calauit Project funds, subject to availability of funds and existing auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and cancels, revokes or amend orders or instructions inconsistent herewith.
