DENR SPECIAL ORDER NO. /225 SERIES OF 1993

SUBJECT: CREATING AN AD-HOC COMMITTEE TO REVIEW, INSTITUTE THE POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS OF NRMP ON SPECIES- AND AREA-SPECIFIC BANS

In the interest of the service and pursuant to the objectives of the DENR in the efficient and optimum utilization of our natural resources, an **Ad-Hoc Committee** is hereby created with the following duties and responsibilities:

- review and analyze the NRMP Policy Study Report on Area-Specific and Species-Specific Bans; and
- 2. draft Administrative Order(s) or any appropriate issuances that will define guidelines, rules or regulations in the adoption of the acceptable recommendation(s) of the above policy study.

The Ad-Hoc Committee shall hold its first meeting immediately and shall submit its report to the Secretary one (1) month after its first meeting.

All expenses incurred by the Committee in connection with its tasks, shall be charged against their respective offices, subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
