Subject : Implementation of DAO No.2 and S.O. No. 25, Re : Ancestral Domain Concepts & Delineation Procedure in Oriental and Occidental Mindoro

Pursuant to the Constitutional Mandate for the recognition and protection of the rights of the indigenous cultural communities (ICCs) to their ancestral lands domains and as a result of the last ADB Mid-Term Review Mission conducted from 06-20 August 1993 in Occidental and Oriental Mindoro for the Low-Income Upland Communities Project (LIUCP), one of the issues identified is the issue of ancestral lands.

In line with this, a Workshop/Seminar scheduled on 21-23 October 1993 to be conducted jointly by the Special Concerns Office (SCO), Natural Resources Management Project (NRMP) and the Low-Income Upland Communities Project (LIUCP) is hereby authorized to be attended by the following:
