SUBJECT: CREATING THE REGIONAL MULTISECTORAL FOREST
PROTECTION COMMITTEE OF NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

In the interest of the service and to cover the functions to monitor, supervise and coordinate forest protection activities in National Capital Region and in conjunction with the National Program, the Regional Multisectoral Forest Protection Committee for National Capital Region is hereby created with the following membership to wit:

They shall exercise their respective functions as follows:

- a. Serve as a collaboration point for all forest protection and forestry activities by carrying the message to the public which its members belong.


- b. Regularly receive and discuss reports from DENR and other relevant parties specific to routine and monitoring, apprehension and prosecutorial activities;
- c. Advise DENR and other relevant parties on these activities;
- d. Publicize the committees discussion and findings (except where treated as confidential);
- e. Directly oversee the public awareness and alternative livelihood programs;
- f. Mobilize the independent networks to which its members belong in support of forest protection activities;
- h. Perform other related tasks.

The Committee shall actively link and use similar committees already existing in the area for forest protection.

The Committee shall meet at least once per quarter to discuss matters of its concerns.

Incidental expenses relative to the Committee's conduct of business shall be charged against the National Capital Region's budget provided for the purpose subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
