SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION OF PERSONNEL IN THE CONDUCT OF TRAINING ON PARTICIPATION OF THE RES IDENTIFICATION, ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING COURSES.

In the interest of service, the following DENR employees are hereby instructed to attend the ten (10) day Introduction to Identification and Survey Methods in Coastal Resources (Coral reefs and Seagrasses) and SCUBA Training Courses to be conducted by FSP - DENR Component to be held on 3 to 12 November 1993.

Expenses for the SCUBA training, accomodations, food and other costs to be incurred during the training shall be charged against FSP - DENR Component (TRUST 102).


