SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION OF THE FIELD PERSONNEL IN THE CONDUCT OF TRAINING ON MARINE RESOURCES IDENTIFICATION, ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING AND SCUBA COURSES.

In the interest of service, the following DENR employees are hereby instructed to attend the ten (10) day Introduction to Identification and Survey Methods in Coastal Resources (Coral reefs and Seagrasses) and SCUBA Training Courses to be conducted by FSP - DENR Component to be held on 3 to 12 November 1993.

Participants to the SCUBA are required to submit their recent (atmost four weeks prior to the training) medical certificates (comprehensive examination) and to bring their own sleeping bags and wet suit or the outfit to be used in lieu of a wet suit for the check out dives.

Expenses for the SCUBA training, accomodations, food and other costs to be incurred during the training shall be charged against FSP - DEMR Component (TRUST 102).

Travelling/transportation expenses of the DENR field employees shall be charged against the FSP - DENR funds released to the Field Offices, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
