DENR Special Order No. 1721 Series Of 1993

SUBJECT:

Amending DENR Special Order No. 609 Series of 1990 on the Creation of a Philippine Spotted Deer Conservation Committee.

In the interest of the service, DENR Special Order No. 609 Series of 1990 dated 28 June 1990 creating the Philippine Spotted Deer Conservation Committee is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Committee shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1. Prepare a long term research and development plan of the Philippine Spotted Deer Conservation Program;
- 2. Monitor and evaluate the progress of the breeding program and propose recommendations to achieve the objectives of the program;
- 3. Recommend any movement or disposition of <u>Cervus</u> alfredi, either original stock or progeny, maintained in breeding centers, both local and international;
- 4. Negotiate the donation of funds for furthering the conservation of <u>C. alfredi</u> and its habitat, as may be proposed and agreed by the Committee, from any individual or institution which may participate in the captive breeding program under the aegis of the future breeding loan extension;
- 5. Formulate guidelines for the most beneficial way of disposing donated funds for the <u>C. alfrediconservation projects in the Philippines</u>;
- 6. Ensure that <u>C. alfredi</u> acquired or bred under the terms of this Agreement and registered in the "World Herd" shall not be sold for profit, or otherwise disposed of without prior consultation and agreement of the Committee, subject to approval of the DENR Secretary; and
- 7. Maintain a copy of the official STUDBOOK of all <u>C. alfredi</u> maintained in and outside the Philippines, or other pertinent documents, reports (published or unpublished), etc. related to the conservation program".

This Special Order takes effect immediately and remains in force until amended/revoked by the Secretary.
