
SUBJECT: Resolution Nos. 93-02 and 93-04 requesting the Secretary to set aside ten percent (10%) of the NRDC bidded logs for the operational funds of the multisectoral forest protection committees and to investigate the alleged involvement of DENR/PNP personnel mentioned in the media in connivance with illegal loggers during the Operation Jerico and to investigate the whereabouts of 2,183.95 cu. m. of logs seized by Task Force 629 in Benito Soliven, Isabela.
