SUBJECT: Creation of a DENR Composite Team to prepare a comprehensive development plan for the TLA areas affected by the logging moratorium in Quirino Province.

1. In line with the policy of the Government to provide equitable access to opportunities in the development of the natural resources and share in the benefits desirable therefrom and in cognizance of the urgent need of alleviating the plight of the residents of the communities adversely affected by the declaration of a logging moratorium in the Province of Quirino, a composite team is hereby created to prepare a comprehensive development plan for the TLA areas affected by the said logging moratorium, which shall be composed of:



2. In the performance of the assigned task, team is authorized to conduct field work and shall gather the necessary data and information needed for the purpose. In addition, the Team or any of its members is also authorized to seek the assistance of DENR Officials assigned in the Region where the project is located, including other Government Agencies whose assistance may be required.

3. All expenses that shall be incurred incidental to the fieldwork shall be charged against the respective offices of the members of the Team, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. The Team shall submit report within ten (10) days after termination of their field work.

5. This Order takes effect immediately.
