SUBJECT : **DESIGNATING CENRO REGIDOR DE LEON AS
SPECIAL OPERATIONS OFFICER FOR REGION 2.**

In the interest of the service and for purposes of testing for better approaches to improve enforcement capabilities in regions, CENRO Regidor De Leon is hereby designated Regional Special Operations Officer (RSOO) for Region 2; as such, he will report directly to the RED, Region 2 and shall perform the following functions.

1. Subject to the supervision and direction of the RED, gather, receive and evaluate information to identify violations in the region of environment and natural resources laws, statutes, procedures and standards.
2. Plan and submit to the RED for approval, operations to investigate and/or curtail indicated violations, including the involvement of and to make arrangements to involve, other nongovernmental agencies and organizations as might be warranted in given case or situation.
3. As may be directed by the RED, organize ad hoc teams or committees to implement planned operations as approved; no one person involved in a previous activity of the RSOO, may be again involved in the future activities.
4. Prepare and present reports to the RED copy furnished the Undersecretary for Field Operations and the Secretary, of operations, actions or investigations conducted, within 48 hours after ending the same.
5. Undertake other tasks as might be directed by the RED.

This designation is in effect unless otherwise revoked by the undersigned or the Secretary.

As RSOO, CENRO de Leon shall be entitled to all benefits and allowances as are allowed his rank and position.
