SUBJECT : Creation of the Coastal Resources
Management Steering Committee
(CRMSC)

1. In the interest of the service and in order to protect, preserve, maintain, rehabilitate and manage the remaining coastal resources of the country. There is hereby created a Coastal Resources Management Steering Committee (CRMSC) under the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and coordinated by other offices concerned, to wit:

2. USEC, Environment and Research --- member
3. USEC Natural Resources and Manangement "
4. USEC Field Operations "
5. Dir. Forest Management Bureau "
6. Dir. Parks And Wildlife Bureau "
7. Dir. Environmental Management Bureau "
8. Dir. Ecosystems Research and Dev't.
Bureau "
9. UERO Staff Representative "
10. Representative from Department of
Agriculture/ Bureau of Fisheries "
11. National Coordinator Coastal
Resources Management Program, and
Director, Secretariat of CRMSC "

2. The committee shall identify and invite one representative from academe and one from Non-Governmental Organization.

3. The committee shall coordinate the institution and implementation of policies that outline the protection, rehabilitation, preservation, development and management of

the coastal resources of the country including but not limited to, coral reefs and other marine resources of the country.

4. The committee shall formulate policy, guidelines, rules and regulations to carry out its functions and responsibilities, and to implement the program effectively nationwide. The committee is likewise authorized to call upon any agencies of the government and any attached bureaus/offices of the Department for assistance, including equipments and implements as may be necessary to accomplish its assigned task.

5. This is in lieu of the present Coastal Resources Management Committee, chaired by USEC Umali.

6. This Order shall take effect immediately and supersede or cancel other special orders inconsistent herewith.
