Subject: Creation of an Inter-Agency Task Force for the Conduct of a National Marine Mammal Survey and Assessment.

In the interest of the service and in order to ensure the effective conduct of a nationwide survey and assessment of marine mammals, an Inter-Agency Task Force is hereby created composed of the following:

Chairman : Director, PAWB
Members :
Four (4) representatives from PAWB
One (1) representative from OSEC/CEP
Two (2) representatives from BFAR
Two (2) representatives from Siliman University Marine Laboratory
Two (2) representatives from University of the Philippines -Marine Science Institute

The Task Force shall be responsible for the preparation and conduct of a detailed implementation plan for the survey and assessment of marine mammals.

The Task Force shall solicit the participation of interested individuals/groups/organizations and recommend the inclusion of interested parties in the committee membership.

The Task Force shall identify possible sources of funds to implement this program.
