SPECIAL ORDER No. 1474 Series of 1993 DEC 2 8 1993

SUBJECT: Designation of Senior Counterparts for the ENR-SECAL Program

In the interest of the service and in order to ensure transfer of technology, facilitate needed actions and provide for an efficient turn-over of operations from the Technical Assistance Teams to the regular DENR organic staff and officials, the following officials and staff are hereby designated as senior counterparts to the ENR-SECAL Technical Assistance Teams:

- 1. RED Wilfrido Pollisco Senior Counterpart for MEC
- RED Jose Gapas Senior Counterpart for RRMP
- 3. Dir. Corazon Sinha Senior Counterpart for IPAS
- 4. Regidor de Leon Counterpart for MEC-Region 2

All concerned Regional Executive Directors in their capacity as ENR-SECAL Regional Program Directors shall act as Senior Regional Counterparts for all the ENR-SECAL components. They are likewise instructed to designate regional counterpart staff for the following areas of concerns:

- 1. Monitoring and Enforcement Component (MEC)
- · aerial, marine and ground operations
- log control monitoring system
- multi-sectoral forest protection committee
- legal technical assistance
- communications
- 2. Regional Resource Management Projects (RRMP)
  - community organizing
  - social forestry and agroforestry
  - infrastructure development
  - training and IEC
  - monitoring and evaluation
  - agribusiness and marketing
  - finance and budget
  - LGU capacitation

The duties and responsibilities of the Senior Counterparts are as follows:

- 1. Under the overall guidance of the ENR-SECAL Program Director, ensure that the activities of the TA Team are coordinated with and supportive of the DENR mandates and regular operations;
- 2. Facilitate actions and decisions needed at higher levels;
- 3. Determine areas of concern where the services of the TA Teams are most needed;
- 4. Together with the team leaders of the TA Teams, recommend to the management through the Program Director policies, strategies and remedial measures to ensure efficient Program implementation and realization of set goals and objectives;
- 5. Ensure linkages and integration of the three ENR-SECAL components; and
- 6. Attend Steering Committee meetings and other workshops and conferences organized under the Program.

The regional counterpart staff on the other hand shall have the following duties and responsibilites:

- 1. Shall be the recipient of technologies and expertise that would be imparted by the TA Team members;
- 2. Together with the concerned TA members, plan and implement activities to support the Program's operations;
- 3. Provide linkages between the TA Team members and the various DENR field operating units;
- 4. Ensure the smooth phasing out of the TA Team; and
- 5. Perform other functions as required by the Regional Program Directors.

This Order takes effect immediately.
