SUBJECT : VALIDATION AND AUTHENTICATION OF SURVEY  
CONDUCTED BY AERIAL FORESTERS  
FOUNDATION, INC. IN CALIRAYA WATERSHED  
RESERVATION.

In the interest of the service, the following personnel of the National Program Coordinating Office (NPCO) one (1) personnel each from PENRO Sta. Cruz, and DENR- Regional Office and five (5) from National Mapping and Resources Information Authority (NAMRIA) are hereby directed to form into two (2) Composite Teams and proceed to So. Magalolon, San Antonio, Kalayaan, Laguna, starting April 1, 1993 until April 20, 1993.

The Composite Teams that will authenticate and validate the survey will be headed by the Senior member of the NAMRIA personnel.

The Tasks of the Composite Teams are enumerated hereunder:

1. Relocate the survey lines and corners established in the area by the AFFI based on the technical description of the map submitted by AFFI and original field notes of the survey, and determine whether the actual area is suited for reforestation or not. In case the areas/parcels relocated contains coconut plantations and other non-plantable portions, the area of said coconut plantation and non-plantable areas should be estimated for exclusion from the area surveyed.




2. In the process, the NAMRIA personnel should use a Theodolite with EDM to check the bearings and distances of the survey lines.

The above Composite Teams shall, within seven (7) working days after completion of their field work, submit their written report to the Undersecretary for Field Operations thru the Chairman, NFP Steering Committee.

The team members shall be entitled to travelling expenses approved under COA regulations subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules chargeable against the funds allotted to their respective offices except NAMRIA personnel whose expenses will be borne by NPCO-DENR Central Office.
