- 3. The Committee shall coordinate the institution and implementation of policies that outline the protection, rehabilitation, preservation, development and management. of the coastal resources of the country including best not limited to, coral reefs and other marine resources of the country.
- 4. The Committee shall formulate policy guidelines rules and regulations to carry out its functions and responsibilities and to implement the program effectively nationwide. The committee is likewise authorized to call upon any agencies of the government and any attached bureaus/offices of the Department for assistance, including equipments and implements as may be necessary to accomplish its assigned task.

- 5. This is in lieu of the present CRMC, chaired by USEC Umali.
- 6. This order shall take effect immediately and supersede or cancel other special orders inconsistent herewith.
