SUBJECT : Investigation of alleged violation of P.D. 705, as amended and other mining laws, rules and regulations in Metro Manila and its vicinities.

In the interest of the service and pursuant to the mandate given to the DENR, the following personnel are hereby directed to proceed to No. 1820 Paz Mendoza St., Paco, Metro Manila to verify a report from Economic Intelligence & Investigation Bureau that around 20,000 board feet of narra lumber/flitches are stocked thereat:



The above officers are hereby authorized to investigate confiscate/seize, if the circumstance or evidence warrants any and all forest products, etc. They are likewise authorized to examine records/documents and take custody of the same if necessary. Further, the above officers may coordinate with and seek the assistance of other government agencies and instrumentalities in carrying out the mission assigned to them as well as secure search warrant if required by the circumstance.

In the pursuit of their task, all DENR Field offices are enjoined to extend their full cooperation and support.

Upon completion of their mission, they shall return to their station and submit report within ten (10) days.

This order shall remain valid until the completion of their mission.
