Above-named personnel shall perform the following functions:

1. To do the work and coordinate with the OEDCI - RME - LGU Specialists in the implementation of the LGU Capacitation Program covering major areas of assistance in capability building, management and supervision and monitoring and evaluation.
2. To facilitate coordinative linkages with DILG and with other appropriate agencies and institutions which have key roles in RME implementation.

a. Assisted in the interpretation and implementation of pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code and other implementing rules and regulations issued by DILG;

b. Coordinate arrangements for DILG meetings and consultation to discuss and iron out policy and technical issues and amendment program for project turn over.

c. Serve as DILG counterpart staff for the OPM DILG Specialists.

All incidental expenses relative to the performance of the above functions shall be charged against the KRMF allotment of their respective offices except for the National DILG Coordinator which shall be charged to PMO-SECAL, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


