Above named personnel shall perform the following functions:

1. Closely work and coordinate with the OEDCI - RIMP LGE Specialist in the implementation of the LGE Capacitation Program covering major areas of assistance in capability building, management and supervision and monitoring and evaluation.
2. Facilitate coordinative linkages with LGUs and with other appropriate agencies and institutions which have key roles in RIMP implementation.

3. Assist in the interpretation and implementation of pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code and other implementing rules and regulations issued by DENR.
4. Coordinate arrangements for LGC meetings and consultations to discuss and iron out policy and technical issues and assessment program for project turn-over.
5. Serve as DENR counterpart staff for the OEDC LGC Specialist.


All incidental expenses relative to the performance of the above functions shall be charged against the RRMP allotment of their respective offices except for the National LGC Coordinator which shall be charged to PND SECAL, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


