SUBJECT: INTEGRATION OF SPECIAL ORDER NO. 52 AND 58 SERIES OF 1992 AND 1993, RESPECTIVELY INTO ONE SPECIAL ORDER AND AMENDING SOME OF ITS PROVISIONS

Scope of Work

1. Review the performance the ENR-SECAL Program and its consultants.
2. From the results of the review, recommend appropriate actions that the Program Management Office must take in order to address the gaps, issues and problems identified.
3. Review and recommend to the ENR-SECAL Steering Committee pertinent policy guidelines/circulars for issuance to ENR-SECAL implementing units.
4. Recommend the allocation of resources and review fund utilization vis-a-vis accomplishments of all the three components of the program.
5. Reports to the ENR-SECAL Steering Committee.

To facilitate the undertakings of the TWG, a secretariat shall be provided by the ENR-SECAL Program Management Office. Said secretariat shall provide all the information and other support needed by the group to effectively perform its duties.


This order shall repeal all other orders inconsistent herewith.
