SUBJECT: CREATION OF SPECIAL TASK FORCE TO FORMULATE OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT (CBFM) FOR MANGROVES.

The Task Force shall have the following functions:

- Formulate and recommend operational guidelines for Community-Based Forest Management for Mangroves; and
- Come up with a systematic methology and mechanism for CBFM to ensure the proper selection of Community Forest Management Agreement (CFMA) awardees.

The Task Force shall submit its progress report and the final draft of the guidelines to the Project Director, National Forestation Development Office (NFDO).

All allowable expenses of the task force which shall be incurred in the discharge of their functions shall be chargeable against the NFF funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This order shall take effect immediately.
