SUBJECT: Reconstituting the Committee to Evaluate
Protests on Appointments.

In the interest of the service and in accordance with the DENR Merit Promotion Plan and System of Ranking Positions, the Committee on Protests on Appointments is hereby reconstituted and shall be composed of the following:

Atty. Chameron Clio L. Borre - Chairma
Director Erlinda P. Meram - Member
Mr. Pedro Pangilinan - Member
Mrs. Lourdes M. Flores - Member
Forester Romulo Cadiz - Member
Mr. Ivene Reyes - Member
Personnel Division - Member

This Committee shall be an advisory body which shall assist the Secretary in the resolution of protested appointments filed by any officer or emplyee for his own behalf. Speciafically, its functions will be:

- 1. Receive, process and recommend action on protests against appointment or promotion in the Department Proper, Bureaus and Regional Offices in accordance with Civil Service laws and regulations and pertinent policies promulgated by the Department;
- 2. Act on cases within thirty (30) days from receipt of the protest;
- 3. Submit in writing to the Secretary its findings and recommendations including a draft of decision for signature/approval.

The Personnel Division shall provide secretariat services to the Committee.

If the protestant is not satisfied with the decision of the Department, he may elevate his case to the Civil Service Commission Merit Systems Protection Board.

This Order shall repeal Special Order No. 1203, Series of 1990 and shall take effect immediately.
