SUBJECT: Creating a Committee tasked to formulate the appropriate scheme in managing the Nasipit Lumber Company, Inc. and Anakan Lumber Company concession areas

1. In the interest of the service, and in view of the current financial and management difficulties of Nasipit and Anakan Lumber Companies, a Working Committee is hereby created composed of the following:

Dir. Lope Reyes (FMB)	- Chairman
Dir. Carlos Tomboc	- Co-Chairman
Representative, Nasipit Group of Companies	- Member
Representative, Nasipit/Anakan Workers Union	- Member
RTD Teotimo Redula (R-10)	- Member
Forester Bayani Nera (FMB)	- Member
Atty. Wilfredo Peñaflor (Consultant)	- Member

2. The Committee is tasked to undertake the following:

- a. Formulate the appropriate plan or scheme/s in managing the Nasipit/Anakan concession areas by considering, among others, its shift from TLA to community forestry;
- b. In the process of formulating said plan/scheme/s, the Committee shall consider and recommend the appropriate actions/solutions on:
- b.1 the rehabilitation of displaced workers of the company;
- b.2 the possible settlement of unpaid legal and other compensation claims of company workers;
- b.3 other alternative employments of displaced workers in forestry projects such as in reforestation, etc;
- b.4 the economic social and peace and order implications of the province of Agusan del Norte most especially the Municipalities affected; and
- b.5 recommend such transitional actions as may be necessary pending the finalization and approval of the recommend plan/schemes.





5. All expenses necessary for the accomplishment of the Committee's task are hereby authorized, subject to the availability of funds and to the usual accounting and auditing procedures;
