The above officers are hereby authorized under these confidential instructions to investigate, confiscate/seize, if the circumstance or evidence warrants any and all forest/mineral products, etc. They are likewise authorized to coordinate with and seek the assistance of other government agencies and instrumentalities in carrying out the mission assigned to them.

Further, the above officers may coordinate with and seek the assistance of other government agencies and instrumentalities in carrying out the mission assigned to them as well as secure search warrant if required by the circumstance.

In the pursuit of their task, all DENR Field offices are enjoined to extend their full cooperation and support.

Upon completion of their mission, they shall return to their station and submit report within ten (10) days.

This order shall remain valid until the completion of their mission.
