SUBJECT : Designation of the Regional Technical Director for Environment In Region 3, as Regular Representative/DENR Action Man to the Regional Mt. Pinatubo Assistance Resettlement and Development Commission.


In the interest of service and for purposes of establishing a practicable work coordination to ensure an efficient, effective and immediate response/action and collaboration with the Regional Mt. Pinatubo, Assistance Resettlement and Development Commission (RMPARDCOM), and agencies involved in the rehabilitation and development of the areas affected by the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo by virtue of R.A. 7637, dated September 24, 1992, the Regional Technical Director for Environment, Region 3, is hereby designated as regular DENR representative/action man to the RMPARDCOM.

Specifically, the RTD for Environment, in addition to his regular duties and responsibilities shall assume the following tasks:

1. Attend regular/special meetings called by the RMPARDCOM;
2. Coordinate and effect related activities in consultation with other agencies such as identification and enhancement of possible resettlement and existing sites respectively;
3. Identify appropriate support livelihood activities to be made available to the people affected by the Mt. Pinatubo eruption;
4. Recommend to the Secretary and his regular alternate pertinent actions needing top level clearance/approval;
5. Render periodic reports to the Secretary, summarizing the major activities, progress and problems of rehabilitation incorporating appropriate actions/recommendations; and
6. Perform other tasks which shall be assigned to him.

The RTD for Environment may exercise discretion on occasion where urgency is required. However, such judgment shall be exercised in accordance with the existing DENR laws, rules and regulations and pertinent order.

This order takes effect immediately and all orders inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked accordingly.
