SOCIO-DEMOGRAPHIC ECONOMIC AND
INSTITUTIONAL SURVEY, ANALYSIS AND
INTEGRATON ACTIVITIES UNDER NRMP-CDRF
WORK ELEMENT.

1. In the interest of the service and in view of the need to institutionalize the efforts being undertaken by the Natural Resources Management Program (NRMP), the following personnel are hereby designated as DENR technical counterparts to the Conservation Development of Residual Forest (CDRF) element-Socio-Demographic and Economic Data Collection, Analysis and Integration activities;

- Specifically, the counterparts shall perform the following tasks and responsibilities:
  - a. Work closely with the CDRF Technical Assistance Team and FMB Counterpart, Dr. Antonio Manila in all phases of the socio-demographic and economic data collection, analysis and integration;
  - b. Assist in the monitoring of data collection and analyses for the CDRF expanded areas;

- c. Work with the CDRF team and the FMB counterpart in linking the socio-demographic, economic and institutional data with the Biophysical Resources inventory during the preparation of Resource Management Plans; and
- d. Participate in training modules on socio-demographic, economic and institutional survey, analysis and integration;
- 3. As technical counterparts they shall be working closely with the CDRF Technical Assistance Team and the FMB Counterpart until the completion of the task.
- 4. All expenses to be incurred in connection with this Special Order shall be chargeable against NRMP funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

This Order takes effect immediately.
