The Monitoring and Enforcement Technical Working Group (MEC-TWG) shall perform the following functions:

- a. Review the performance and accomplishment of the four subcomponents of the Monitoring and Enforcement Component and its consultants;

- b. From the results of the review and evaluation, recommend appropriate actions that the Program Management Office must take in order to address the gaps, issues and problems identified.
- c. Analyze and study the systems, proposals, procedures, manuals developed by the consultants and recommend their approval, rejection or modification to the Steering Committee,
- d. Provide other support services to the Program.

Expenses of the Monitoring and Enforcement Technical Working Group (MEC-TWG) in connection with the implementation of its mandate and approved program of activities shall be charged against ENR-SECAL Program funds and other available Department resources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

In cases when the members of the group are not available to carry out their tasks, they may designate alternates in consultation with the ENR-SECAL Program Management Office.


This order takes effect immediately and shall continue to be in force until revoked by subsequent order.
