- The said training is a four (4)) day seminar/workshop 4. designed to enable the DENR staff to carry out effective monitoring and evaluation of Forest Resource Inventory field work undertaken by selected Forestry Service Organizations (FSOs) within their respective areas of assignment.
- 5. All expenses to be incurred shall be chargeable against NRMP Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing procedure.
