




2. The participants shall be required to attend all the sessions and practicum of the said training. They are also expected to implement/practice the learnings in their respective NRMP-CDRF monitoring assignments.
3. The training shall be assisted by two (2) NRMP support staff.
4. The said training is a four (4) - day seminar/workshop designed to enable the DENR staff to carry out effective monitoring and evaluation of Forest Resource Inventory field work undertaken by selected Forestry Service Organizations (FSOs) within their respective areas of assignment.
5. All expenses to be incurred shall be chargeable against NRMP Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing procedure.
