

The above-mentioned personnel shall undertake their fieldwork in Cordillera Administrative Region, Regions 3, 4, 5, 7, 10 and 11 within the period August 9 to October 16, 1993. They shall be authorized to seek the assistance of Regional, DENR, and CENR officials and staff in the conduct of their task.

They shall be authorized to claim transportation and travelling allowances and other incidental expenses, chargeable against funds of their mother units, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall remain in force within the period specified.
