All administrative procedures for the day to day operations of the project shall follow the applicable provisions of DENR Memorandum Order No. 5 series of 1993.

All expenses that will be incurred thereto shall be charged against the PRRP-RRS funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

This Order takes effect immediately and supersedes all Orders inconsistent herewith, and shall remain in force until otherwise revoked in writing.
