The committee shall conduct investigation of the M & S IFMA No. 20 with the end in view of uncovering the alleged illegal activities undertaken by M & S Co. in their area particularly the sightings made by the ENR-SECAL Team that conducted the aerial surveillance created under Special Order No. 1296, Series of 1993.


The committee shall secure copies of the reports of the committees created under DENR Special Order No. 1285 and 1296, both Series of 1993, as a take-off point in conducting the verification work.

The committee shall likewise coordinate with the Regional Executive Director of Region XII and the Southern Command for transportation and other logistic arrangement needed in the conduct of the verification work.

The team shall submit a report supported with pertinent evidences within 15 days after the investigation.

The committee shall be considered disbanded without prejudice to recall after the investigation is conducted and report submitted.

All travel and expenses incurred as a consequence of this Order shall be charged against the fund of the Office of the Undersecretary for Field Operations subject to existing COA regulations.
