SUBJECT: Creation of a Population Management Committee for Calauit (PMCC) to oversee the removal of excess animals from Calauit Game Preserve and Wildlife Sanctuary.

In accordance with DENR Administrative Order No. 64 dated November 4, 1993 Population Management Committee for Calauit (PMCC) is hereby created composed of the following:

- 1) Undersecretary for Environment and Research - Chairman
- 2) PAWB Director - Vice-Chairman
- 3) Palawan Council for Sustainable Development representative - Member
- 4) Regional Technical Director for EMPAS, R-4 - Member
- 5) Chief, Wildlife Division, PAWB - Member
- 6) NGO representatives (two) - Member
- 7) Chief, Administrative and Finance Division, PAWB - Member
- 8) DENR Legal Affairs Office representative - Member

The Committee shall have the following functions:

- 1) prepare an annual list of animals for disposition, including the number per species, age and sex;
- 2) screen and identify qualified buyers/recipients;
- 3) determine the species that may be taken in exchange for animals from Calauit;
- 4) process necessary documents and oversee the disposition of the animals;
- 5) monitor and assess status of animals taken from Calauit in a semi-annual basis or any time deemed necessary;
- 6) establish a data bank on the animals disposed from Calauit; and
- 7) submit reports including recommendations to the Secretary from time to time.

The Wildlife Propagation and Special Projects Section, PAWB shall serve as Secretariat to the Committee and provide administrative and technical support. It shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- 1) assist the Committee in screening and identifying qualified buyers/recipients;
- 2) process the necessary documents and permits in the disposition of the animals;
- 3) undertake liaison work for the Committee on matters requiring coordination with buyers/recipients; and
- 4) prepare schedule of Committee meetings, and record the minutes/proceedings including Committee recommendations.

The Committee is authorized to avail itself of the assistance and services of any employee of the DENR in the performance of its tasks.

The Committee is also authorized to seek the assistance of other government agencies, NGOs and individuals in the monitoring and assessment of the status of animals taken from Calauit.


The Committee members are entitled to reasonable travelling expenses and other expenses incurred in the performance of its tasks, chargeable against the funds of their respective Offices or IPA Funds for Calauit Game Preserve and Wildlife Sanctuary.

This Order takes effect immediately and supersedes all other Orders inconsistent herewith.
