SUBJECT: Creating an Ad-Hoc Committee to Plan for a Simultaneous Tree Planting Nationwide in 1994

1. In order to strengthen and make more effective the tree planting activities pursuant to Executive Order Nos. 99-A and 113 dated June 12, 1993 and July 22, 1993 respectively enjoining all sectors to participate in tree planting activities and in aid of the National Forestation Program an Ad-Hoc Committee is hereby created to be composed of the following:


Chairman - National Coordinator for Urban & Roadside Forestry

Vice-Chairman - National Coordinator, National Forestation Development Office

Members/Rep. - Forest Management Bureau  
Ecosystem Research & Development Bureau  
Environmental Management Bureau  
Protected Areas & Wildlife Bureau  
Regional Executive Director, DENR-NCR  
Financial Management Services  
Special Concerns Office  
Planning & Policy Studies Office  
Public Affairs Office  
National, NGO Desk Officers

A subsequent Special Order shall be issued as soon as the official representative from the offices cited above shall have been confirmed.

2. The Committee shall be tasked to plan for a simultaneous tree planting nationwide in May or June, 1994 with DECS, DND, DILG, DPWH, CSC, YMCA, Freemasons, Private Sectors, Civic and Professional Organizations, NGOs, POs, etc.
3. The Committee shall coordinate with the national head of offices of the above mentioned agencies and instrumentalities (Item 2 hereof) in the implementation and execution of the planned activities.
4. The Chairman is hereby authorized to designate additional members and/or assistance from any government agencies, NGOs, POs and to create regional Ad-hoc Committees.
5. The Plan shall be submitted to the Secretary on or before February 04, 1994.
6. All expenses to be incurred in connection herewith shall be shouldered by the Office of the Secretary.
7. This Order shall take effect immediately.
